The Go Green account will be used on the Dairy Ridge parking area. Plans are still being developed.

Fishing for Fun May 7 income statement was reviewed. Total is \$2503.77 net income. We will plan for 200 kids next year instead of 150. Also we can ask Costco to donate rods and reels. We ended up paying \$11 per rod and reel.

James, Fern and volunteer Wes were there to cook and serve food along with Palmetto Conservation Foundation. A heavy thunderstorm soaked all and many left after dinner. This event is scheduled for next year as well.
